Atypical anorexia nervosa: All of the criteria for anorexia nervosa are met except that CHOC Care Guideline Admission Criteria Patients are admitted for vital sign instability, significant electrolyte abnormalities, cardiac disturbance, or being less than 75% mean Body Mass Index (50% for height and weght) or considered
