London and Theatrical Career It is not known exactly when Shakespeare began writing, but contemporary allusions and records of performances show that several of his plays were on the London stage by 1592 He was well enough known in London by then to be attacked in print by the playwright Robert Greene in his Groats-Worth of Wit:
